

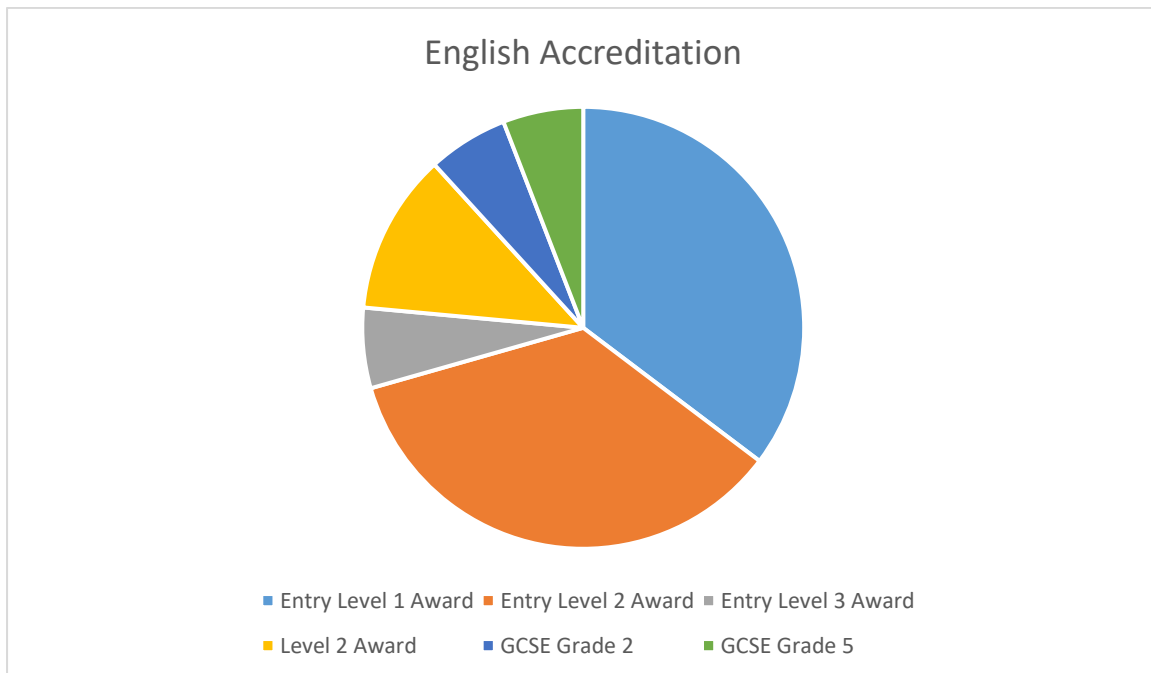
Coppice Accreditation Headlines – Class of 2020-2021

The staff at Coppice Academy are enormously proud of the resilience, effort and dedication shown by the students in this cohort. They have shown great maturity when adapting to changes needed in the school environment due to the pandemic and their hard work through their final year is certainly reflected in their outcomes and achievements.

English

All Year 11 students left with a range of English accreditation, ranging from Entry Level 1 through to GCSE grade 5. Within the cohort, 94% of students made outstanding progress and achieved their accreditation target, with 35% of these students exceeding their accreditation targets.

The chart below shows the final English accreditation achieved for each of the Year 11 cohort.

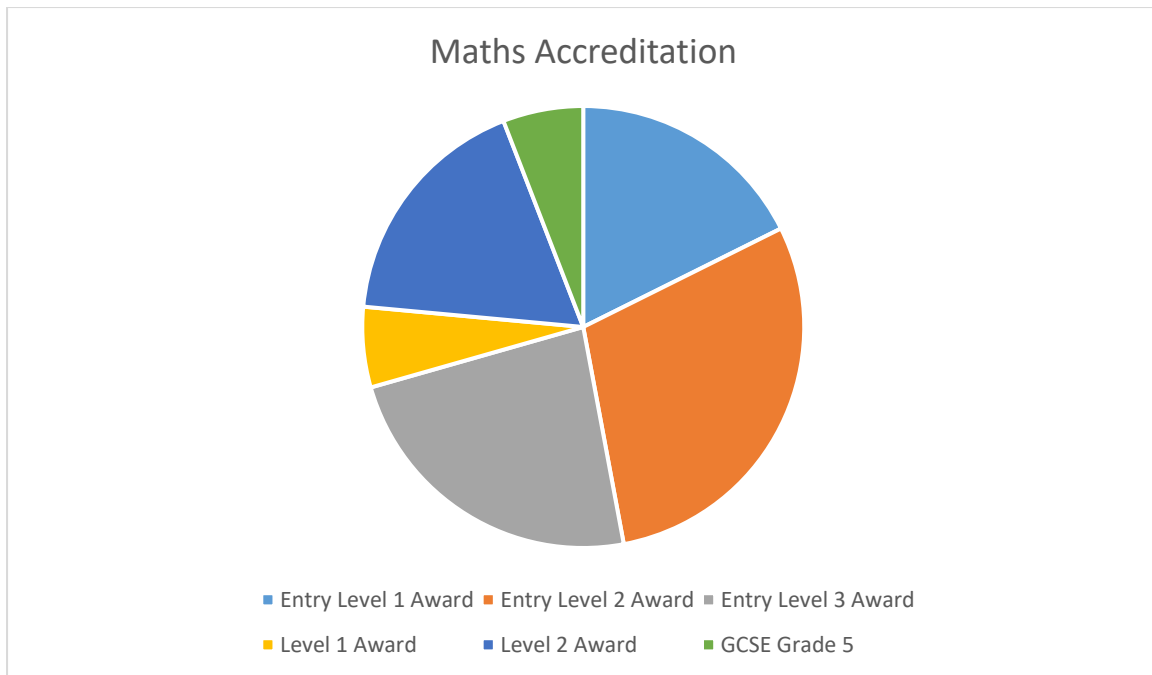


- *Those students who achieved level 2 accreditation also achieved GCSE English grade 3.*

Maths

All Year 11 students left with a range of maths accreditation, ranging from Entry Level 1 through to GCSE Grade 5. Within this cohort, 100% of students made outstanding progress and achieved their accreditation target, with 24% of these students exceeding their accreditation targets.

The chart below shows the final maths accreditation achieved for each of the Year 11 cohort.



In addition to the above, five year 10 students entered for maths GCSE achieved the following:

- 1 x Grade 5
- 2 x Grade 4
- 1 x Grade 3
- 1 x Grade 2

ASDAN

88% of students left with an ASDAN accreditation, this includes COPE Level 1 award; ASDAN personal progress and ASDAN PSHE Short Course. Those students who did not gain an ASDAN accreditation gained BTEC Entry Level 2 Certificate in Independent Living.

Personal Progress - 43% of the students who are leaving with ASDAN Personal Progress accreditation achieved the diploma, the remaining students achieved the ASDAN Personal progress certificate.

COPE – 88% (7 out of 8) students achieved the full COPE Level 1 award, with the remaining achieving completed accredited units. 100% of these students also successfully completed the ASDAN PSHE short course.

BTEC

82% of the year 11 cohort have left with BTEC Awards ranging from Entry Level 2 to Level 1 – this covers a range of subjects which include science, music, art, IT, land based studies, construction and independent living. 71% of the cohort achieved 1 or more Level 1 BTEC award. 29% achieved 3 or more Level 1 BTEC awards and 12% achieved 4 level 1 BTEC awards. 53% of the cohort have also completed additional BTEC Level 1 units in various topics.

AQA Unit Award Scheme

Students have completed a range of AQA Unit Awards ranging from Entry Level to Level 2.

76% of the cohort have achieved at least 1 unit award with 53% of the cohort achieving at least 6 unit awards.
