
English

All Year 11 students left with a range of English accreditation, ranging from Entry Level 1 through to GCSE grade 7. Within the cohort, 100% of students made outstanding progress and achieved their accreditation target, with 55% of these students exceeding their accreditation targets.

Highlights include:

- 45% of the cohort achieving grades in GCSE English
- 25% of the cohort achieving Entry Level 3


Maths

All Year 11 students left with a range of maths accreditation, ranging from Entry Level 1 through to GCSE Grade 5. Within this cohort, 100% of students made outstanding progress and achieved their accreditation target, with 45% of these students exceeding their accreditation targets.

Highlights include:

- 40% of the cohort achieving Level 1 Maths
- 35% of the cohort achieving grades at GCSE


Computing Accreditation

Within the cohort, 85% of the students have left with Computing accreditation ranging from a partial Level 1 certificate in IT User skills through to a Level 2 Certificate in IT skills.

Highlights include:

- 50% of the cohort achieved the full level 1 certificate in IT User Skills
- 10% of the cohort achieved the full level 2 certificate

The chart below shows the computing accreditation achieved for each of the Year 11 cohort.




Science Accreditation

Within the cohort, 85% of the students have left with Science accreditation ranging from a Level 1 Award in Applied Science and Technology through to a Level 2 Award in Applied Science and Technology at Merit standard.

Highlights include:

- 25% of the cohort achieved the Level 1 award
- 25% of the cohort achieved the Level 2 award at merit standard

<u>Gateway</u>

100% of the year 11 cohort have left with Gateway Awards ranging from Entry Level 2 to Level 1 – this covers a range of subjects which include art, construction, progression (citizenship), hospitality and catering, and independent living.

Highlights include:

- 70% of the cohort achieving a minimum of 1 x Entry Level 3 award
- 60% of the cohort achieving a minimum of 1 x Level 1 award

OCR ELC Humanities

45% of the cohort have achieved an Entry Level Certificate in Humanities

- 2 students achieved Entry Level 1
- 7 students achieved Entry Level 2

AQA Unit Award Scheme

Students have completed a range of AQA Unit Awards ranging from Entry Level to Level 2.

95% of the cohort have achieved at least 3 unit awards with 55% of the cohort achieving at least 5 unit awards.
