

<u>English</u>

All Year 11 students left with a range of English accreditation, ranging from Entry Level 1 through to GCSE grade 4. Within the cohort, 100% (13) of students made outstanding progress and achieved their accreditation target, with 31% (4) of these students exceeding their accreditation targets.

Highlights include:

- 15% (2) of the cohort achieving grades in GCSE English
- 31% (4) of the cohort achieving Level 1


<u>Maths</u>

All Year 11 students left with a range of maths accreditation, ranging from Entry Level 1 through to GCSE Grade 5. Within this cohort, 100% (13) of students made outstanding progress and achieved their accreditation target, with 46% (6) of these students exceeding their accreditation targets.

Highlights include:

- 31% (4) of the cohort achieving Level 1 Maths
- 38% (5) of the cohort achieving grades at GCSE.


Computing Accreditation

Within the cohort, 92% (12) of the students have left with Computing accreditation ranging from Entry Level unit awards through to level 1 certificate in the subject.

Highlights include:

• 46% (6) of the cohort achieved the level 1 certificate in IT User Skills

The chart below shows the computing accreditation achieved for each of the Year 11 cohort.




Science Accreditation

Within the cohort, 62% (8) of the students have left with science accreditation ranging from a Level 1 Certificate in Applied Science and Technology through to a Level 2 Certificate in Applied Science and Technology at Merit standard.

Highlights include:

- 23% (3) of the cohort achieved the Level 2 certificate at pass standard.
- 23% (3) of the cohort achieved the Level 2 certificate at merit standard.

<u>Gateway</u>

100% (13) of the year 11 cohort have left with Gateway Awards ranging from Entry Level 1 to Level 1 – this covers a range of subjects which include art, construction, progression (citizenship), hospitality and catering, and independent living.

Highlights include:

- 62% (8) of the cohort achieving a minimum of 1 x Entry Level 3 certificate.
- 23% (3) of the cohort achieving a minimum of 1 x Level 1 certificate.

OCR ELC Humanities

62% (8) of the cohort have achieved an Entry Level Certificate in Humanities

- 1 student achieved Entry Level 1
- 5 students achieved Entry Level 2
- 2 students achieved Entry Level 3

AQA Unit Award Scheme

Students have completed a range of AQA Unit Awards ranging from Entry Level to Level 2.

38% (5) of the cohort have achieved at least 3 unit awards with 15% (2) of the cohort achieving at least 6 unit awards.
